# HEN


What can a hen look and sound like? List as many facts about chickens as you can.


# **BREAD**

# ON THE FARM

Activity Requirements: variety of art materials 15-20 minutes

Our story takes place on a farm, where the Little Red Hen lives. What does the farm look like? What grows there? Who else lives there? Think of another animal that lives in the farm and give them a name. What do they do all day? Who are their friends?

Draw or discuss what you think the farm looks like, and what other animals live there - including your own special animal.

Bonus: sing 'Old MacDonald Had a Farm' using everyone's original creations.

## THE BIG PICNIC

Activity Requirements: variety of art materials 15-20 minutes

The farm is having a big picnic, and every animal is bringing their favorite food to share. There will be fun games and prizes for the animals. Pick an animal and choose their most favorite food and favorite game. How will they spend their time at the big picnic?

## THE NEXT DAY

Activity Requirements: variety of art materials 15-20 minutes

The very next day, all the animals decide to surprise the Hen by making them food- but they don't know the recipe! They need your help to create a recipe for an original dish.

Create a recipe for a new type of food that lists what ingredients are needed and what the animals need to do. List out each step (First, Second, Then, Finally). Is this a breakfast food, or is it for lunch, dinner, or dessert? Draw what the food will look like, and discuss it with your group.

# A RIVAL CHEF

Activity Requirements: variety of art materials 15-20 minutes

A new animal has arrived on the farm and they are a very good chef! In fact, they challenge the Little Red Hen to a cook-off! Create a new animal character and what kind of food they will make for this cooking competition. Think of a story that has a BEGINNING, MIDDLE, and END.

Draw or discuss a scene showing what happens, and share it with your group.
